- 2) All classes to use Natural Plant Material (NPM), Floral Foam may be used. All exhibits judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual 4th Edition (2023), to be viewed and judged from the front.
- 3) Novice class 78, exhibitor not to have won a first place at an Open show.
- 4) The judge's decision is final.
- 5) The Marquee is an off white/cream colour. Displays will be on tabling, approx 75cm deep, covered with green fabric. Open staging.
- 6) All displays to remain until 5:00pm on Sunday.
- 7) Please park to unload in the Exhibitor drop off point outside the perimeter fence and use the entry gate at the rear of the Horticulture marquee, vehicles will need to be moved to the main car park after unloading. No vehicles will be allowed on the showground on Saturday or Sunday.

Class 71 POLE TO POLE - a pedestal exhibit. Space allowed width 90cm, depth 90cm, height optional. To be staged against side of marquee, viewed and judged from front.

Competitor to supply own pedestal, plinth and stand for elevation. Main placement to be uppermost.

- Class 72 EVERYTHING UNDER THE SUN an exhibit incorporating a basket. Space allowed width 75cm, depth 75cm, height optional.
- Class 73 REACH FOR THE STARS an exhibit. Space allowed width 75cm, depth 75cm, height optional.
- Class 74 INTO THE WILDERNESS an exhibit featuring foliage. Space allowed width 75cm, depth 75cm, height optional.
- Class 75 THE SILK ROAD an exhibit. Space allowed width 75cm, depth 75cm, height optional.
- Class 76 BELOW THE WAVES a petite exhibit. Space allowed width 25cm, depth 25cm, height 37.5cm.
- *Class* 77 TROPICAL ISLAND a miniature exhibit. Space allowed width 10cm, depth 10cm, height 15cm.
